

Safety

Dear Parents.

Please help to keep the area around Cecil Swanson School as safe as we can.

This information is being sent home due to continued observations regarding the driving and parking habits around the school. It is hoped that this material will not only help to increase the safety in the area but also educate you in the hopes you can avoid infractions that may result in a ticket.

Please work with us to keep the children as safe as we can and not put them at unnecessary risk due to the driving and parking standards.

School patrols will continue to be carried out by both the Calgary Police Service and the Calgary Parking Authority.

GENERAL TIPS

- All school zones in the city are changing to playground zones. These will be in force everyday from 7.30am to 9pm. Please check the signs at the start of the school zones for changes.
- While the zone is active the speed limit is a maximum of 30km/hr.
- You cannot pass or overtake while the zone is active.
- Many of the restrictions are clearly signposted so please pay attention to the signs.
- Please be courteous to other road users.
- Familiarize yourself with all of the road signs so that you understand the meaning.
- Remain vigilant at all times.
- Ensure every person in the vehicle is properly secured.
- Ensure your vehicle is legally parked/ stopped before allowing any person to enter or exit it.
- Not all of the restrictions are posted as they are general city wide rules that stand at all locations.
- Only cross the road at designated crossing areas.

LOCATION

The school is basically surrounded by playground / greenspaces, Rundlewood Drive at the front of the school and Rundlehill Drive to the north. Dr. Gordon Higgins and St Rupert schools are to the northwest. The playground zone / school zone is extensive as the 3 schools share common playgrounds. Speed limit throughout is 30 kmph.

Of Note: **Rundlewood Drive** directly in front of the school is a no stopping zone to allow a safe area for the school busses to load and unload children and is **clearly posted**. Please respect this area and the supervisors who are out on a regular basis to make sure the children are safe.

Crosswalks have a minimum distance for stopping/parking of 5 meters unless otherwise posted.

U-turns in front of the school are prohibited and place your children and others in serious danger!

REMEMBER: The safety of all is paramount!
